

PLAY-ALONG CONCERT FEE SCHEDULE FOR DR. CRAIG WOODSON

***Audience Numbers** – refers to the total audience members, not just instrument makers.

Conducting – refers to conducting the audience in two or three play-along pieces. This includes a rehearsal on the day of or day before the performance.

Workshop – refers to making instruments with students (1) just before the performance (2) during the performance, or (3) at schools before the day of the performance.

JUST BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE: This might take place in the concert hall or in the lobby area or other adjacent area. Participants would assemble instruments in groups with an instructional page and with direction by me and/or volunteers whom I train. This will last around one hour, and actual instrument making will last only a few minutes per person.

DURING THE PERFORMANCE: Participants would come into the concert hall to find a bag of supplies on their seat. At the beginning of the concert or at some other time during the concert, I will direct the audience in assembling the instruments and how to follow my direction during the play-along portion. Standard works: Raymond Scott – Powerhouse; John Oswald – Spectre.

AT A SCHOOL: If I go to a school or schools (one or more days before the event), the fee is for one workshop (two or three classes or 60 students) outside of the Northeast Ohio area is \$175.00 and in Northeast Ohio is \$150.00. In schools, there should be a minimum of 3 workshops in a day and a maximum of 5 per day. Each workshop will last one hour and the teacher needs to be present. It helps to have one or two volunteer helpers (parents) for each workshop. I also need a small microphone/PA and a blackboard; students can sit on the floor. During these in-school workshops there is more time to work with students composing music, performing on their instruments and having them try conducting, all in advance of the play-along concert.

Materials – refers to supplies that I prepare for use in making/assembling musical instruments with the participants in the play-along portion of the concert.

Other charges – refers to additional costs in a play-along concert budget.

Shipping – usually several boxes of parts need to be sent UPS to the venue.

Transportation – refers to air flights outside of Northeast Ohio to the venue. This also refers to ground transportation to and from the performance site.

Per Diem – refers to between \$45.00 and \$65.00 per day for food and expenses.

Accommodation – refers to overnight stays necessary for the performance.

Arranging – refers to a fee of \$100.00 per hour for arranging a play-along part to go with a given composition.
